

## Public Transport

There is a frequent bus from Glasgow city centre to Glasgow Airport, the journey takes around 15 minutes. It is then around a 20-minute walk to the National Manufacturing Institute Scotland (NMIS) and the Medicines Manufacturing Innovation Centre. Details here:

## Taxis

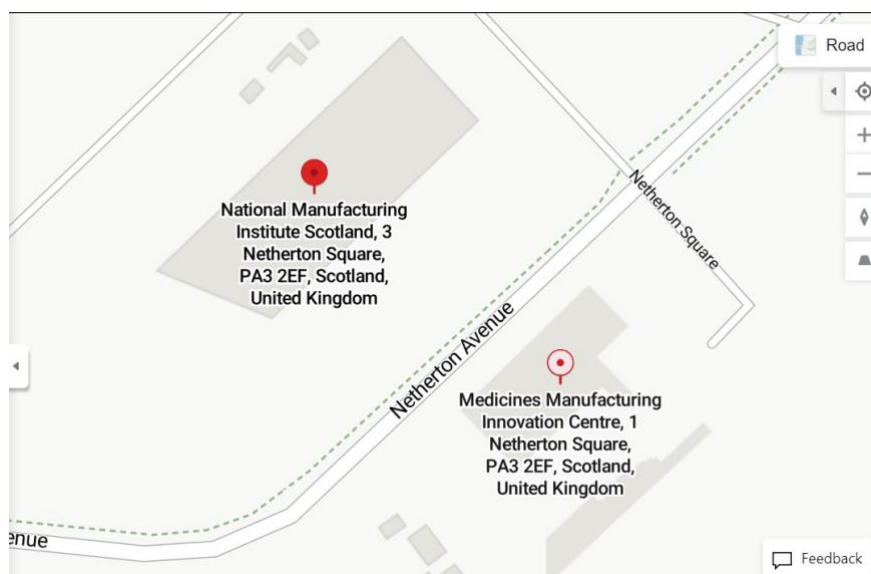

## Mini Bus for Delegates (End of Event)

The Medicines Manufacturing Innovation Centre has organised a minibus (29 seater) for the end of the day to drop any delegates to either Glasgow Airport or Paisley Gilmour Street train station – the journey will take 5/10 minutes. The bus will run on a loop, the first one leaving at 1630 hrs then every 30 minutes through to the last bus leaving at 1830 hrs.
